What to know about your stay at Kemp Station's Mead Residence Hall:



Quiet time is 10:00 pm to 6:00 am. Socializing during this time should be done away from sleeping rooms.



WiFi password is kempstation. Internet access is also available via data jacks and Ethernet cables are available in the office.



You are responsible for your own housekeeping and must clean up after yourself. Wash, dry and put away dishes. All areas are to be left as they were found, including furniture placement. Cleaning supplies are available in the Janitor's Closet. Safety Data Sheets are in a folder labeled SDS. Report maintenance needs to any Kemp staff member.



Kemp Station is a SMOKE-FREE campus. Use of tobacco, smoking, and vaping (ecigarettes) is prohibited on Kemp Natural Resources Station property which includes all indoor and outdoor spaces and Kemp owned vehicles.




Place trash and recyclables in proper bins.

Take full bags of trash and recycling to the dumpsters located near the Pavilion before departure, or as needed. Can liners are available in the labeled top drawer at Kitchen entrance. Place food waste in compost bucket.



You must receive prior approval to have guests on site.





You must sign and submit an "Alcohol Beverage Policy & User Agreement" to have these beverages on Station property.



A coin-op washer and dryer and soap vending is available for use in the lower level of the Mead Residence Hall. The nearest Laundromat is in Lake Tomahawk, behind the snack stand.



Clean **bed linens** are in the vestibule closet. Place used sheets, pillowcases and blankets in the vestibule closet in a laundry bag before departure. <u>Mattress pads should not be placed in laundry unless they are soiled.</u>



Pets require prior approval and are only permitted in the lower-level guest rooms and lower-level hall of the Mead Residence Hall. The Office/Lab and the Cabin are also pet-friendly buildings.



During a power outage, the alarm system in Mead will sound. To silence the alarm, press ACK on the panel across from elevator.



Camping is **not permitted** on Station property. Persons wishing to camp may do so at nearby campgrounds.



In case of life-threatening emergency, call 911. Your location: Mead Hall, Kemp Natural Resources Station, 9169 Kemp Road, Woodruff.



Mead residents may use other Kemp facilities such as the boat launch, fire ring, and Boathouse provided that such use does not disrupt the activities of other Kemp users or groups. Please respect that these are common Station resources and be courteous in your use of them.
